



# RELATIONSHIP IMPACTS ON TREATMENT STUDY

## Are you:

- **Assigned female at birth (cis-gender woman, nonbinary or transgender man who was assigned female at birth)**
- **Aged 18-45, able to read/understand English, US resident?**
- **Someone who has experienced infertility?**

## Have you experienced *any* of these things?

- **Violence, threats, stalking, or fear in your relationship?**
- **A partner who pressured you to get or stay pregnant, or to have an abortion?**
- **A partner who has tampered with your birth control, so that you would get pregnant.**
- **A partner who has pressured you to seek infertility treatment, or to stop using it?**

You may be eligible to participate in the *Relationship Impacts on Treatment (RIT) Research Study*, that is being conducted by the George Mason University School of Nursing to better understand the impact of relationship factors on infertility treatment.

## WHAT does the study involve?

A 1-minute eligibility screener survey.

An interview using a secure, online platform, that will take up to an hour, to talk about your experiences.
